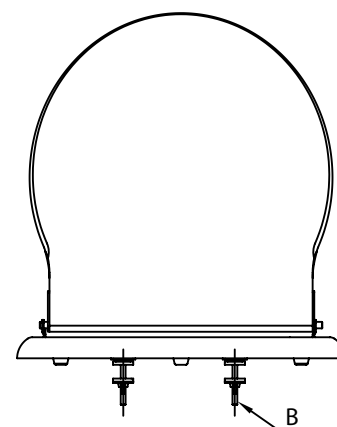
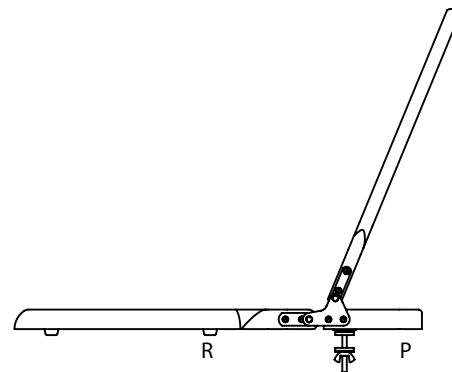


Fitting Instructions

Please Note: 3 rubber buffers are provided with our seats. We recommend fitting these to the underside of the seat as seen on the drawings. However to avoid scratching when the seat and lid are lifted together 2 further rubbers can be fitted to the underside of the lid. Please be aware however that the rubber buffer will mark the seat if you choose this option.

1. Place loo seat on wc pan and adjust to desired position.
2. From underneath the pan, make 2 marks on the underside of the backpiece (P) through the lug holes.
3. Attach the two fixing bolts at these points (B) using 2 cross-head screws set diagonally opposite each other.
4. Put the seat in position and fasten the wing nuts.
5. Check the position of the seat relative to the pan.
6. Using a soft (HB) pencil mark the position of the rubber buffers (R) on the underside of the seat.
7. Remove the seat from the pan. Predrill 3 small holes being careful not to drill through the underside of the seat.
8. Attach the buffers using the slotted screws. N.B. Do not over-tighten the screws as they will cut into the rubber.
9. Reattach the seat to the pan



Care and Maintenance

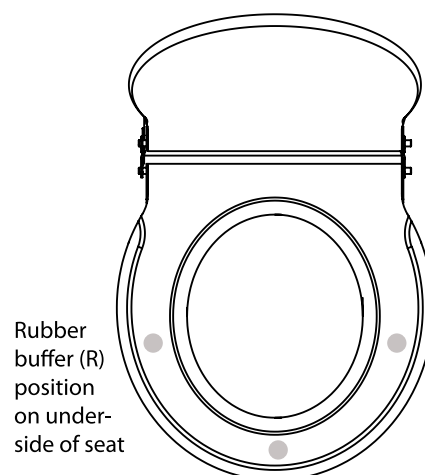
We recommend that our seats are kept clean by wiping with a warm damp cloth or sponge (a mild diluted detergent can be used if required). For best results, it should then be dried with a paper towel or duster. Furniture spray polish or beeswax can also be used.

Never use any bathroom or toilet cleaning products as they may damage the lacquer.

If your seat requires refurbishment, the surface may be polished with a light furniture oil. Any excess should be polished away with a dry cloth.

Replacement rubber buffers are available from most good hardware stores. Alternatively, we can supply a set for a small charge.

N.B Do not sit or stand on the lid when the seat is closed
Always lift the lid and seat separately to avoid scratching the lacquer.
